### **Migration**

- L. S. Amend Elliott Larson Civil Rights Act to include sexual orientation and gender identity
- S. Fund affordable housing development and permanent supportive housing as part of the State's Affordable Housing Plan and through increased investments in the State's Housing Trust Fund
- S. Expand State Earned Income Tax Credit
- S. Invest in community based mental health supports
- S. Support Ban the Box provisions
- F. Support Child Tax Credit restoration

## **Peacemaking**
